The meeting suggested some remarks about drafting reports in the future and to highlight the technical activities more than management and coordination ones. (27/6/2006).

A meeting of all members of the Office was held with the Website Technician. During the meeting the new format of the website was reviewed and agreed upon what has been updated.

The General Manager, Dr. Hussein Elobied accompanied by Mr.Yusuf of OSIL paid a visit to the Nuba Mountains during the period from 5-9/3/2007. The visit aimed at standing on the available capacity, encouraging national partners and testing their commitment to work in the Mine Action Project financed by the World Bank, and to create awareness and gain the support of key players to support the program. The visit also aimed at inspecting JASMAR's Office at Nuba Mountains and finding solutions to some problems

The General Manager held a meeting with the Administrative Manager and MRE team in Khartoum to discuss the preparations for developing the JASMAR's permanent exhibition. (12/4/2007).

the new staff of the MAG aimed at monitoring the progress of the work and finding solutions to problems that have emerged there. During the trip, number of meetings was held with official bodies and non-governmental organizations, in addition to many meetings with the Association staff in Blue Nile Project. Many of these meetings were in participation of the new MAG staff. Full report has been prepared for the journey. (30/11-6/12/2006).

Regarding field visits to Kassala State:

The Executive Director of the Association paid a visit to Kassala State. The trip was aimed at establishing a branch of the Association there and introduction of JASMAR to the relative authorities and non-governmental organizations. During the trip, a number of meetings were held with both the Acting State Governor and Minister for Engineering Affairs, Minister of Local Government, the Government Secretary-general, Governor of Hemshkourib, the Humanitarian Aid Commissioner, the Director of Security Bureau, the Director of the Red Crescent, the United Nations Mine Action Services, and the Disabled Union. After the interviews Mr. Luay Mohamed Osman has been selected as a Coordinator for the Association's Office in Kassala. It was agreed with him on a program of action for the next phase. (12-14/12/2006).

The Association held a workshop for strategic planning for the next five years at the

Grand Holiday Villa. Participants were more than thirty from JASMAR's offices of Khartoum and the States, foreign partners (MAG), the National Mine Action Office, the Humanitarian Aid Commission, a number of national organizations of common interest and the DDR. As a result of the workshop, now the Association has its strategy for the coming five years. (August 2006).

phase of the project in April 2006, at a cost of \$ 75,000. The number of the people targeted who received awareness messages through various means during the project period (six months) is around (85.930). During the project period, the Project Manager, the General Manager and The Executive Director have paid visits covered all the teams in their locations. The activities have been reflected in weekly and monthly reports to all relevant actors. After signing with UNICEF on the new phase with duration of one year, starting from November 2006, the project recruited all new elements needed. A workshop is held for the MRE teams. The teams participated in the field visit to test new materials to be used in awareness. Also the teams started the field work in Khartoum, Aldaien and Kosti. The number of people who received awareness messages during the third phase is around (69.026). The activities

have been reflected in weekly and monthly reports to all relevant actors. Liquidation for the first installment of the project budget for the first three months (November 2006-May 2007) has been completed.

Applied for the organizations' membership of the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations. Membership application been sent together with all required documents via the Internet and a hard copy to New York with the delegation of organizations participating in the meetings of the Special Committee on the Convention of Disabled. (August 2006). We have received confirmation from the Council that



they received the request. The application will be discussed in January and then we will be informed later (September 2006). DCA Organization and for reasons concerning finance, stopped the common demining program implemented with JASMAR. This will take effect from the beginning of the year 2007. (November 2006).

JASMAR implemented through Advocacy for the Rights of People with Disabilities Project in Blue Nile four workshops in the areas of Rights Bill in the Transitional Constitution, Organizations Management, Leaders Training and Leadership Aware of Gender. (Jan< Feb and March 2007 . Also JASMAR celebrated, in the end of the workshop, the signing of the International Convention for the Rights and Dignity of People with Disabilities, which coincided with the commemoration of the signing the Convention in New York on the same date (March 30, 2007). It is noteworthy that the Sudan among eight countries had signed the Convention. In the end of the pro-

ject, final and evaluation reports have been submitted to the British Embassy.

An agreement was signed to implement the Landmine Impact Survey Project in Kassala with Mines Advisory Group. (03-08-2007).

The Operations Officer participated in the National Strategic Framework Workshop for Victims Assistance at Juba in 14-03-2007

Kosti (2) team leader participated in the training of some personnel of humanitarian organizations, the Ministry of Education and the African Union on mine risk education program in El Geneina and Zalingei during the period 12-19/3/2007.

JASMAR organized information campaign on mine risk awareness in Asalam Camp in collaboration with the United Nations agencies and organizations involved in the mine action. (19/3/2007). JASMAR organized the march on the occasion of the International Mines Awareness Day and participated in the exhibition accompanied the celebration in Police Club on 04-04-2007.

JASMAR organized Information Campaign on mine risk awareness in Damazin with participation of the United Nations agencies and organizations involved in mine action. (24-04-2007).

JASMAR prepared permanent exhibition consists of a photo exhibition, paintings and stereophonic of a minefield. (April 2007).

Khartoum team leader participated in mine risk education workshop for the training of teachers, in the Ministry of Education during the period 16-17/4/2007 in Khartoum.

JASMAR full members in the headquarters participated in a workshop about Mines Problem in the Sudan in the National Assembly. The General Manager delivered speech on behalf of the national organizations; also the Association participated with an exhibition that reflected its different activities. (05-19-2007).

Coordination Activities:

With (Mine Advisory Group(MAG))

Three meetings have been held with the British MAG. Participants in these meetings were Valeria and Philip, separately. Participants from JASMAR are Dr. Hussein Eloeid, Abuosama Abdullah Mohammed, Mohamed Abdel Rahman Elbushra and Israa Mohammed Alhaj. The meetings discussed the affiliation of the national project staff and some other administrative arrangements in addition to the project ongoing activities in Blue Nile (June 2006).

Held a number of meetings with the delegates of the MAG in JASMAR headquarters in Khartoum. Participants discussed at two of them with Philip upon his request the deliberations of what happened during a previous meeting with

Valeria in which the theme of national staff affiliation was discussed. Another meeting included from JASMAR Dr. Hussein, Abu Osama and Mohammed Elbushra and from MAG John Wallace, Abigail, Philip and Valeria. The most prominent outcomes of the meeting is the agreement on the exchange of reports, the development of a new memorandum of understanding, determining what JASMAR wish to achieve in the future (strategic plan), JASMAR involvement in the next phase of Mine Risk Education Project funded by UNICEF in Blue Nile. MAG also expressed their satisfaction on the financial performance of JASMAR. Also MAG paid outstanding payments due to JASMAR. (July 2006).

A meeting was held with the Country Program Manager of the MAG Sudan. Partici-

pants in the meeting from JASMAR were Dr. Hussein Alobied and Abuosama Abdallah. During the meeting it was agreed to form a memorandum of understanding between the two organizations supposed to be renovated as from September, valid for two years (August 2006).





A meeting was held with representatives of the MAG (Valeria and Philip). Participants from JASMAR were Abuosama Abdullah and Mohammad Elbushra. During the meeting, participants deliberated on the Implementation Agreement of the Consortium Project in Kurmuk and Gissan. JASMAR representatives animadverted comments on the draft prepared by them. Some JASMAR comments were considered by MAG representatives and asked to consult their administration on others (August 2006).

The General Manager of the Association held a meeting with Valeria Fabroni of the MAG. During the meeting the Landmine Impact Survey Coordinator was introduced to JASMAR. The meeting also looked into the UNHCR request to provide mine awareness in Damazin. During the meeting it was suggested that Babiker Mohamed shall be defined as JASMAR instead of JASMAR/ MAG Coordinator (September 2006).

- The Executive Director of the Association held a meeting with Mis. Abigail, MAG Country Program Manager in Sudan. During the meeting it was agreed on the implementation Agreement of the Landmine Impact Survey Project in Blue Nile and then signed it. The meeting also discussed the complaints of partners staff against each other at the field sites, it was agreed to solve such problems through joint visits of senior staff of the two organizations. With regard to the information sharing and specially the budgets, Abigail refused to give details

upon instructions from her headquarters. (October 2006).

- The General Manager of the Association held a meeting with Mr. John Mcfarlane the new Technical Operations Manager of MAG. The meeting discussed partnership projects between the two organizations and ways to overcome its imperfections problems. During the meeting, John provided a project proposal to open roads in Kassala for comment. (November 2006).

- The Executive Director participated in the meeting of the European Union, which included representatives of both MAG and JASMAR and the European Commission. During the meeting the two organizations submitted a proposal for establishing two demining teams in Blue Nile to be funded by the European Commission. Also JASMAR has been introduced and information was shared about its activities and areas of interest with the European Commission Rural Development Officer. (October 2006).



- The General Manager and the Executive Director of the Association held a meeting with Abigail, MAG Country Program Manager in Sudan and Steven (from MAG headquarters). During the meeting, MAG Country Program Manager provided briefing on the progress of projects and funding position for the next phase. During the meeting, Survey Project in Kassala State, the Administrative Support Cost of Kurmuk and Gissan Consortium Project and Surveying Project in Blue Nile were discussed. It was agreed to pay joint field visit at the end of January. It was agreed to recruit Medical Assistant from South Kordofan to work in Blue Nile. An agreement was reached to share information about each of the job description for the JASMAR Coordinator in Kassala, the actual cost of the Survey Project in Blue

Nile till December, the funding proposal submitted to DIFD. The meeting has been acquainted with the arrival of the new Projects Officer, Frederick. (18/1/2007).

- The Executive Director of the Association held a meeting with MAG delegation composed of Abigail, Country Program Manager, Steven Persley from MAG headquarters, Frederick, the projects Officer and Omar Ali, the Finance and Administration Manager. The

meeting has been enlightened with the steps undertaken regarding the starting of the Survey Project in Kassala. The most important point was that, the Survey Action Center (SAC) wish to implement the work without national partner. Participants discussed the information sharing between the two organizations, especially on the details of budgets. (JASMAR Headquarters, 29/1/2007).





The Executive Director, and the Administration and Finance Manager of JASMAR held a meeting with Mr. Frederick (MAG Project Officer). During the meeting it was agreed that JASMAR will be an integral partner in the survey project in Kasala state (7/2/2007). Subsequently, the project documents and the job description of JASAMR Coordinator of the project have been shared.

- The Administrative and Financial Man-

ager held a periodical coordination meeting with Mr. Frederick of the Mines Advisory Group. The meeting discussed the projects of the partnership between the two organizations, where Mr. Frederick briefed on the movements and the appointment of new international staff members in existing projects. Attendees expressed their opinions about the performance of the Consortium project, where it was agreed that the work is going very slowly due to some differences between the partners and the lack of agreement on the Memorandum of Understand-

ing for the second year. (04-02-2007).

- The General Manager of the organization and Administrative and Financial Manager held a meeting with a delegation of MAG headed by Miss Abigail, Country Program Manager. The objective of the meeting was to introduce the new international personnel whom are: the Medical Officer, MRE Manager and Technical Field Manager. (05-10-2007).

With (Danish Church Aid (DCA):

A meeting was held between both Mahesh from the DCA and Dr.Hussein Elobeid, the meeting discussed a number of issues topped by the capacity building, the Implementation Agreement of the project, JASMAR Strategic Planning workshop (June 2006).

A number of e-mails been exchanged with Mr. Mahesh from the DCA on JASMAR eligibility to receive a share of the cost of man-

During the meeting it was agreed to a final solution for the exchange of information and involvement of JASMAR in the preparatory phase prior to submission of proposals to donors, in addition to a proportion of projects admin-



agement. Ideas were also exchanged on the transfer of DCA office from Umsirdiba to Kadugli, in addition to the submission of a concept paper of a project funded by European Union in Khartoum (June).

A meeting was held with Mr. Ramadan Algot DCA Finance Manager. The meeting was attended by both Abuosama Abdullah and Hamid Ali Ibrahim Coordinator of Nuba Mountains. During the meeting, a number of outstanding points were discussed such as the final installment of the Capacity Building

- The Executive Director of JASMAR held a meeting with Mr. Jacob envoy of the DCA organization from Copenhagen. The meeting discussed a number of topics, the major one is the change of the program in the Nuba Mountains which is intended to raise the level of discipline and productivity, the reaction of JASMAR staff there and treatments required. It was also agreed to exchange information among the partners, especially periodic reports, drafts of projects, and involvement of JASMAR since the preparatory stages, contribution of the project in covering JASMAR expenses at the headquarters level. The freezing will be effective as from the beginning of the next year. DCA has committed to pay dues of staff.



A meeting was held with the delegation of DCA Organization. Participants from JASMAR were the General Manager and the Executive Director and from DCA Christian Bach, the Director of International Relations and Nils, the Interim Country Manager in Sudan. The meeting was enlightened by DCA delegation visit to the Nuba Mountains. The guests are in the process of formulating a new strategy in which raising awareness and collecting unexploded ordnance will continue while demining will be frozen due to lack of funding. Regarding their response to the letter which they received from the National Mines Ac-

tion Office for handing over the demining equipments JASMAR to continue the work, they refused the idea pretext that they did not decide to leave Sudan and they are in the stage of searching for funding. It was agreed to exchange documents for the new strategy, projects proposals and other documents with JASMAR. (21/1/2007).

The Executive Director of JASMAR held a meeting with the Danish church Aid, where he discussed the Memorandum of Understanding, the Implementation Agreement of the project and re-recruitment of JASMAR staff in Nuba Mountains without prior notification. DCA rejected the idea of handing over JASMAR demining equipment despite freezing the demining. The General Manager met with a delegation from DCA in JASMAR Office. The delegation briefed the General Manager about the new appointments at DCA headquarters level at Copenhagen and the program management in Sudan. The Gen-

eral Manager also briefed the delegation on the results of his visit to the Nuba Mountains. The meeting also discussed the deminers suing to DCA at the court. Parties have agreed to resolve the issue amicably. (18/3/2007).

The General Manager of JASMAR and Administrative and financial Manager held a meeting at JASMAR Office with DCA officials. The objective of the meeting was to introduce the new Country Manager and discuss the partnership issues. (27/3/2007).

The General Manager held a meeting with DCA. The objective of the meeting was to discuss the dues of the demining team in Nuba Mountains. (21/4/2007).

Kurmuk and Gissan Consortium :

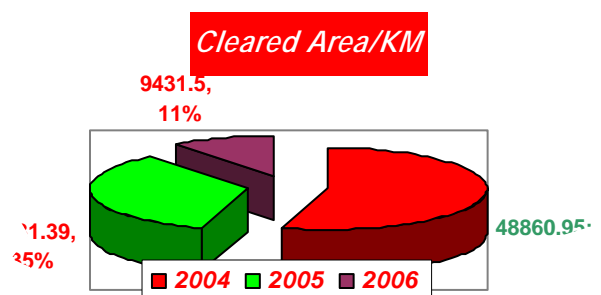
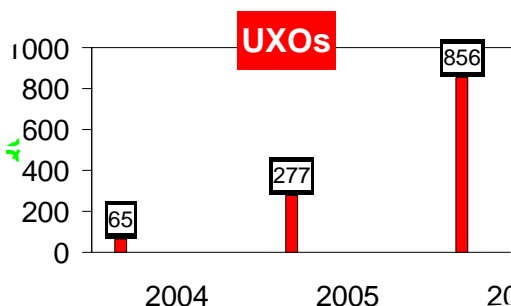
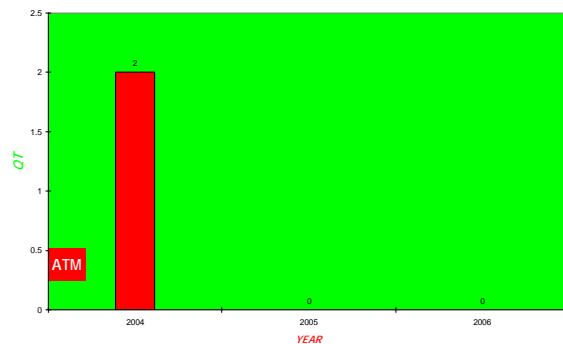
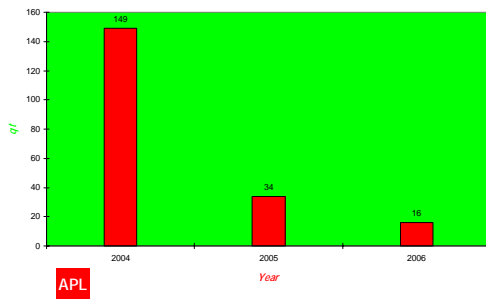
Kadugli Office

period (22-24/4/2007).

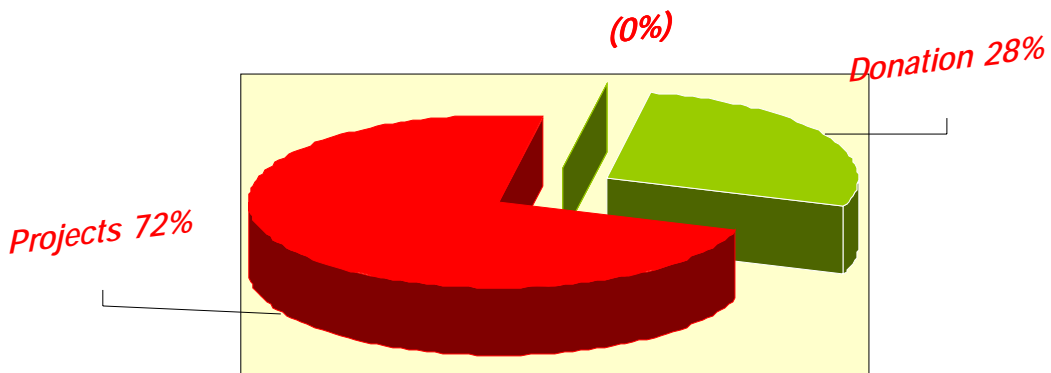


Financial
